

VISITING WITH INPATIENTS

Hospital policies starting from

November 1, 2023 (Wed)

※ Management may differ in some wards. Further instructions will be given on admission.

■ Visiting hours: Daily from 2pm to 7pm

* These are also the same hours for those who only need to pick up and drop off personal belongings.

■ Visiting policy per patient: Once a day up to 30 minutes, maximum of 3 visitors per day.

■ Visitors: Relatives or persons equivalent to relatives (hereafter referred to as "relative, etc.") and accompanying persons.

* Please be sure to bring your 'Permission Slip' previously provided by the hospital.

* The accompanying person may visit only when accompanying a relative, etc. who has a 'Permission Slip'.

* As a general rule, children under 2 years of age are not allowed to visit.

■ Place available for visits: Patient room or Day Room

* **Both patients and visitors should wear masks. Non-woven masks are recommended.**

* **Eating and drinking are prohibited during visits.**

■ How to visit: ① Apply for visitation at the Security Office "BOUSAI SENTAA".

② Submit the visitor application form with your 'Permission Slip' to receive a card holder with neck strap before coming to the ward.

③ After arriving at the ward, please notify the nurse in the staff station.

④ When you leave, only return the card holder with neck strap to the return box located at the exit of the Security Office.

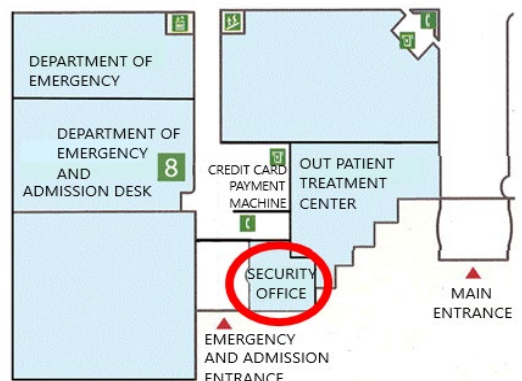
■ Online visitation is also available.

Visit is not allowed in the following cases:

● If you have any of the following symptoms:

- ✓ A fever over 37.5°C, tiredness
- ✓ Cough, difficulty breathing, phlegm, sore throat
- ✓ Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea
- ✓ Skin rash

● If you have had COVID-19 within 10 days.



Please note that visits may be prohibited again depending on the prevalence of infectious diseases and other factors.
